PUBLISHERS' NOTE

THIS volume in its first form was a series of papers contributed by Mr. Fields to *The Atlantic Monthly* in 1871, under the title "Our Whispering Gallery." In republishing the papers in their final form, he gave to the book the title it has since borne. The long continued popularity of the work and its very friendly and personal character have led the publishers to reissue it with an enrichment of portraits and facsimiles of autograph letters, drawn, by the courtesy of Mrs. Fields, from the collection begun by Mr. Fields and continued by her.
