

Мир растений: Пособие для студентов педагогических институтов
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Пособие содержит тексты на английском языке о растениях и их роли в жизни человека, об экологических проблемах, о взаимоотношениях человека и окружающей среды. Представлены тренировочные задания познавательного и проблемного характера.

9. Pour water over the dirt and fertilizer around each tomato plant.
10. Use a hoe to scrape a small amount of dry dirt on top of the wet dirt around each plant.
11. Remove any weeds and grass that might grow around the tomato plants during the next few weeks with your work gloves and the hoe tool.
12. Water your tomato plants as necessary to maintain moist, but not saturated, soil around the base of the plants.
13. Observe the yellow blossoms that will appear on tomato plants within a few weeks after they are planted. These blossoms will soon turn into miniature tomato fruit.
14. Watch closely the small green tomatoes as they begin to appear to make sure that no insects are present.
15. Apply insecticide or natural predators as necessary to control any harmful insects that are found.
16. Remove any rotten or mildewing tomatoes as the fruit begins to turn from green to pink in color.
17. Carefully pluck the ripened tomatoes as they change completely from pink to a deep red color.
18. Wash the red tomatoes with clean, cool water and put them on a dinner plate.
19. Slice the red tomatoes into thin cross-sections, approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ inch in thickness.
20. Place the slices of the red tomatoes in between two slices of sandwich bread, and 'go to eating'.
21. Enjoy the delicious "fruits" of your labor!

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
