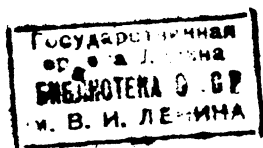

My Letter in the *Athenæum* of the 18th Feb. last was necessarily written on the spur of the moment, and it will not surprise the reader that it should have stood in some need of correction: the corrections, with additional matter, chiefly in the shape of documents, are supplied in the following pages. Here and there a few new circumstances have since occurred to my memory; and these I have also inserted, as well as enlarged others.
