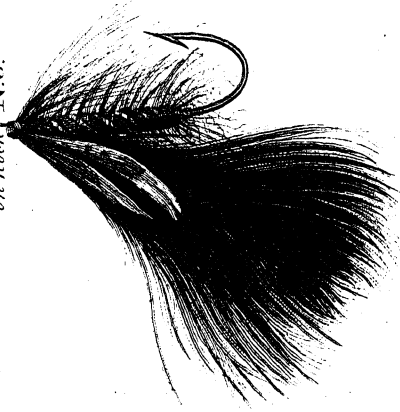

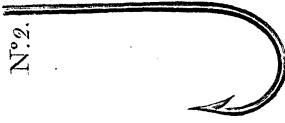

on hook N^o 3.



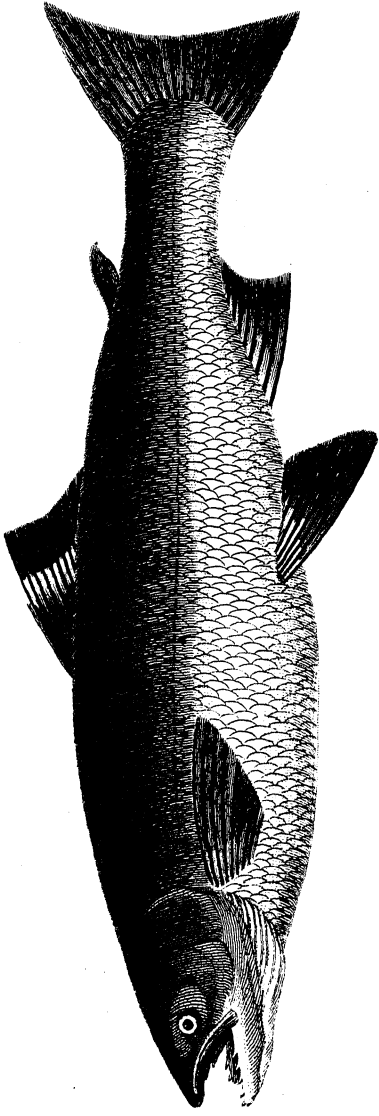
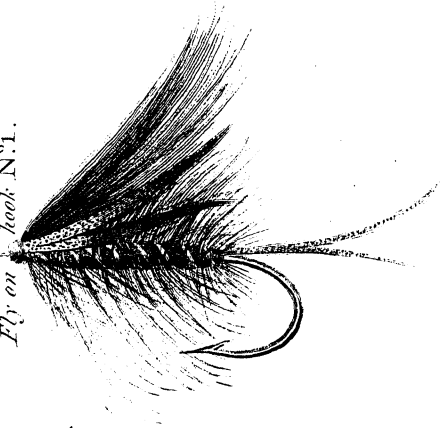
