PREFACE.

IN arranging for publication the present collection of my papers on Mathematical and Physical subjects, I have taken the dates of their first publication as a general rule in fixing the order of the various papers.

In certain cases, however, I have considered it advisable to bring together under one article all that I have written on one particular line of research; the most important instances of this being Articles *XLVIII.*, *XLIX.*, and *L.* Article *XLVIII.*, "On the Dynamical Theory of Heat," and Article *L.*, "On Thermodynamic Motivity," includes all of my papers on this subject, published between the years 1851 and the present time, except the Article "Heat" of the *Encyclopædia Britannica*, published in 1880. Article *XLIX.*, "On the Thermal Effects of Fluids in Motion," consists of a joint series of papers by Dr Joule and myself published at various intervals between 1853 and 1862.
