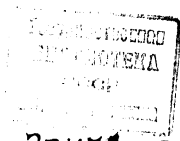

PREFACE TO THE SECOND EDITION.

THE first three Lectures, on Body and Mind, and the last two Essays, in this volume, appeared in the First Edition.
