THE BATTLE OF KIRK-KILISSE.

The battle of Kirk-Kilisse took place at the commencement of the Balkan War of 1912. General Savoff directed the Bulgarian main attack against Kirk-Kilisse, though the initial disposition of the forces gave the Turks the impression that Adrianople was the enemy's first objective. From October 22nd-24th the Bulgarians were engaged north and north-west of the town, on which front the Turks had attempted a night attack with 70,000 men. The Turks were repulsed, a panic ensued amongst them, and on October 24th the Bulgarians captured Kirk-Kilisse, in which there was a large quantity of supplies.
