




PREFACE

In the present volumes are contained only the shorter Essays by the late Sir Peter Le Page Renouf : necessarily such works as his standard edition of the Book of the Dead, the Hibbert Lectures, as well as his Egyptian Grammar, have not been included.

When it became my duty to collect the titles of his varied and numerous writings, difficulties met me at every step; and had not assistance been readily given by kind friends, my labours would have been greatly increased.

This being accomplished, the necessity of collecting together, in a series of volumes, the writings themselves, became clear. Scattered through many different publications, difficult to obtain out of England, indeed, often difficult to procure in England itself, they must necessarily be often overlooked. Their importance is undoubted, and they not only demand honour to the writer of them, but also to the country which produced such a Scholar.
