PREFACE

THE articles contained in this volume were compiled by Mr. R. Hughes-Buller, I.C.S. The collection of material entailed special difficulties, owing to the large area to be covered and the less highly organized staff of officials as compared with other parts of India. Mr. Hughes-Buller received valuable assistance from Major C. Archer, Indian Army, Revenue Commissioner in Baluchistān; and he also wishes to acknowledge the help given him by Rai Sāhib Dīwān Jamiat Rai in collating information about what has hitherto been an unknown country.
