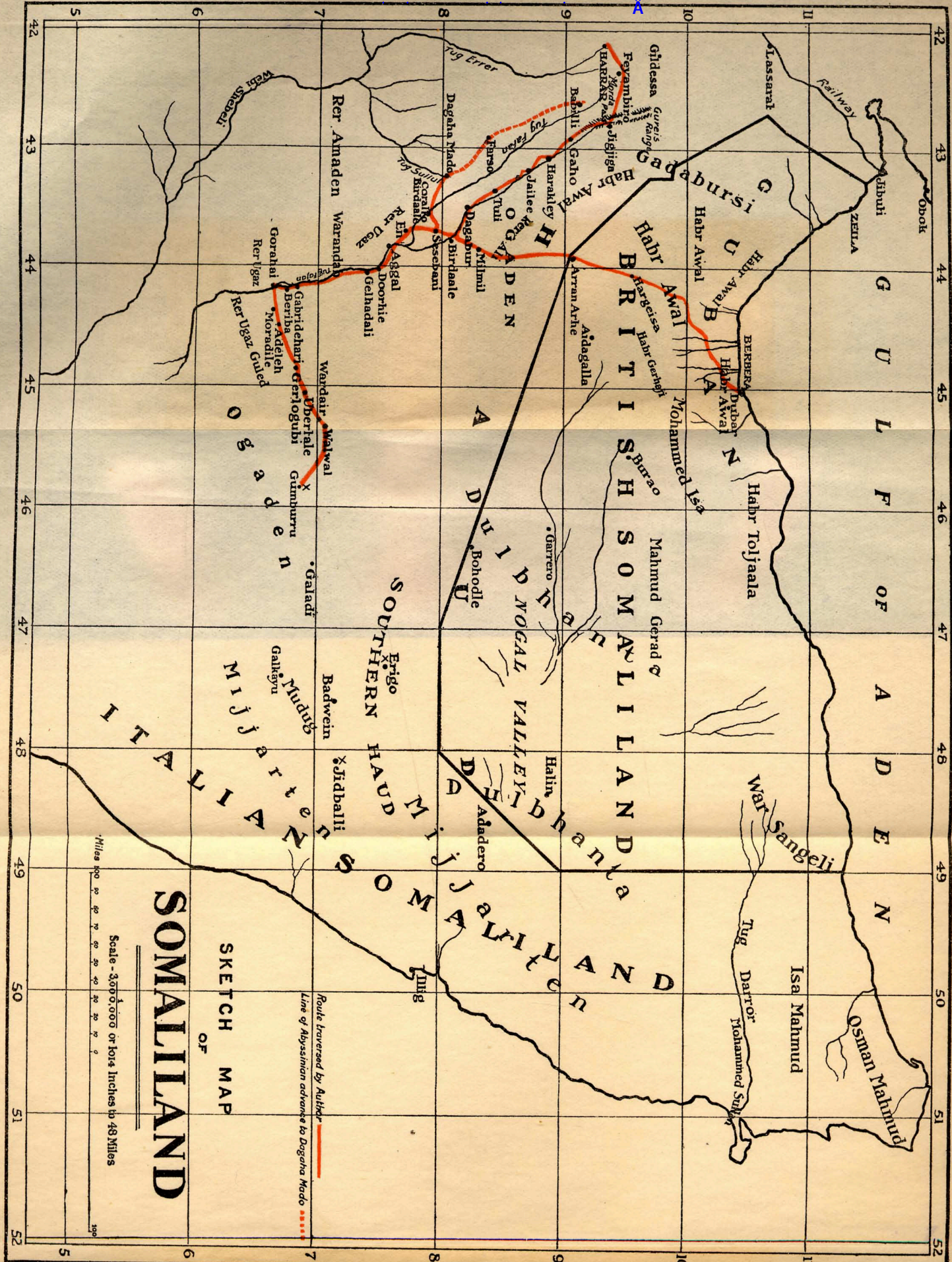

## PREFACE
